Set in beautiful wooded grounds on the outskirts of Ballymena, Tullyglass Hotel is family owned and was originally built as a highly specified gentleman's residence. With these roots, the directors have retained many references to its past and the hotel is renowned for its relaxing atmosphere, quality of service and high quality food using local produce.

The hotel is centrally located in Northern Ireland, adjacent to the spectacular Glens of Antrim and close to the Causeway Coast, both recognised for their outstanding scenery. A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY

The original building was constructed in the second half of the 19th century, along with extensive gardens, stables and paddocks.

The ownership has included Hugh Rainey, a successful local merchant also deeply involved in horse racing, JB McAllister, a well-known Ballymena whiskey distiller who achieved sales throughout the world and the O'Kane family, early entrants into industrial scale chicken processing.

ACCOMMODATION

Tullyglass Hotel offers a selection of 46 bedrooms. 33 elegant bedrooms are based in the original building, and therefore in this world of uniformity, each is a little different to the next. The common theme for our rooms is luxury and comfort, and each room has its own en-suite bathroom, a flat screen TV, free Wi-Fi, a business work station, and we also provide a complimentary breakfast.

The Residences which are within the grounds of the hotel offers a further seven luxury en suite rooms and is ideal for smaller groups, such as management teams, that wish to stay together.

Our friendly staff offer a warm welcome, speedy check-in and check-out, and we try to meet the needs and expectations of each guest, whatever their requirements.



















DINING

Our Post House Carvery is informal, but renowned for its choice and quality of food, while McAllister's Bar and Restaurant offers everything from tempting freshly prepared bar snacks in Austins Bar, to the gastronomical experience of gourmet food in the intimate setting of the restaurant itself (complemented, if you choose, by our selection of fine wines). Mcallister's also has a wide range of specialist whiskeys, reflecting the heritage from the time of JB McAllister.









SPACE FOR BUSINESS AND OTHER EVENTS

Within the hotel we have a number of high-quality and flexible spaces, that can accommodate for example meetings, business events, bus tours and many other events, dependent upon each client's specific needs.

To give some idea, the smallest of these is known as The Residences and is a self-contained building within the grounds of the hotel. It was designed to primarily cater for management teams requiring privacy, but subsequently a range of users have found it ideal for their needs. It offers a meeting room and a separate catering capability, along with seven luxury en suite bedrooms.





Our Corinthian Suite can cater for up to 200 guests or delegates within the main body of the hotel. This has been used for conferences, smaller exhibitions and a wide range of other functions. It also has the advantage of its location beside our Conservatory Suite, which offers an alternative meeting space prior to an event.

Our largest space, the Clock Tower Suite is made flexible through acoustic partitioning, but can accommodate up to 850 when dining, or 2000 when used Theatre style.

Throughout the hotel we can also offer break-out rooms in order to meet specific customer needs.


